(4) M6X20 Countersunk Allen Head (replacement pads)



STEP 1 Using a #4 allen tool. Double check that all four countersunk skid pad bolts are secure. These bolts should be hand tight.





STEP 2 | Using your chosen 5/8" hitch pin, install the hitch skid into your tow hitch receiver.

Note: If planning to leave the hitch skid installed for long periods of time, we recommend using a locking hitch pin.











STEP 3 | DV8 offers replaceable skid pads (Aluminum or Delrin) Part# UNHS-APAD/ UNHS-DPAD.

To replace the skid pad first clear material that had folded over the counter sunk allen head bolts.











STEP 4 Using a #4 allen tool, remove the (4) M6 counter sunk allen head bolts and remove the damage skid pad.





STEP 5 Use a rag and vehicle detailer to clean off the surface area the new skid pad will mount to.







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STEP 6 | Place the new skid pad onto the hitch.

Using the new M6 counter sunk bolts provided in UNHS-APAD/ UNHS-DPAD and a #4 allen tool, loosely secure all four bolts first.



















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STEP 7 | Congratulations, installation of the Xtract Hitch Skid is now complete.
